7. Glenview School District 34

- a. Teachers and Staff gave a presentation on English Language Learner programs at Hoffman, Henking, and Springman Schools.
- b. Nearly 25% of our students come from homes where a language other than English is spoke, 43 languages are spoken in the homes of our students. Approximately 15% of our student population receives ELL support. 50% of these students speak Spanish.
- c. The ELL programs are relational and holistic working with families, students, mentors and teachers, in the classroom, at home, and in the community.
- d. At Springman the ELL program for Latino's is call the Latino Youth Program which has had great success in behavioral and academic performance through mentoring, field trips, and events with families.
- e. Henking works with 50 families through PALMA – that creates partnerships in education with parents and students. Summer reading/ride programs.
- f. Hoffmann MAPA is a relational program that helps families navigate the American Education System, which is different than the educational system in so many other countries.
- g. Many of these programs are funded by a Title I grant.
- h. We are offered an open invitation to share or participate any the aspects of these programs.
