6. Program Officer Sanchez of the Glenview Police Department of the recently disbanded Tactical Unit gave us an update on Gangs and Drugs in Glenview.

- The three major gangs in Glenview – Gangsters Disciples, Latin Kings, and Sorrenos have decreased significantly to the point of no or minimal activity.
- The bigger problem in Glenview is drug use. Of 10 cars stopped 5to6 have marijuana. Cocaine, heroine, and pills (adderall/vicodin/ambien) are the most common drugs in Glenview.
- 2C-E is a LEGAL drug also known as “Tucy” or “Europa” and should be making its way into the drug scene in Glenview by summer.
- When you see something – even if its trivial, like beer cans or graffiti- please report it to 911- this is how the police now get their most current info on illicit activity.
- Also own your space. Be outside, walk your dogs, it keeps illicit activity away.
- If you see kids drinking or smoking pot, call the police, it’s the best help you can get them.
