6. Program Overview and tour of the new Glenview Public [Library](#):
 - a. Thanks to Vicki Novak and staff for hosting
 - i. Planning for the new library began in 1997 with Needs Assessments that continued for several years
 - ii. Upon the grand opening of the new 85,000 sq. ft facility in October 9, over 6100 visited on opening day.
 - iii. Since opening the library has seen a 200% increase in reference inquiries, 1000% increase in meeting space usage, a 100% increase in internet computer use. The building affords a 10% increase in print collection size.
 - iv. The Library building is fully encompasses the site –designed to be very flexible for future change, environmentally friendly and sustainable (43% energy savings) and geared towards socialization. Hence, the ground level of the library is noisier than the upper floors and that is intentional!
 - v. Parking structure to be complete by May 1st.
 - vi. Still some furniture to be delivered
 - vii. Reminded of the ability for unincorporated citizens are able to get a subsidized library card.
 - viii. Tour followed at the end of the presentation.
